








AMERICAN CHAMBER OF COMMERCE IN UKRAINE (AMCHAM)

We are pleased to announce significant news!

The Children of Heroes Charitable Fund has formally become a member of the American

Chamber of Commerce in Ukraine (Am Cham) and the U.S.-Ukraine Business Council (US UBC).

CHILDREN OF HEROES BEGIN COOPERATION WITH THE MINISTRY OF EDUCATION AND SCIENCE OF UKRAINE



An important milestone for our team:
The **Children of Heroes** Charity Fund has signed a Memorandum of Cooperation with the **Ministry of Education and Science of Ukraine**, led by Oksen Lisovyi.

Together, we will collaborate to create educational programs that empower the Children of Heroes to recognize their potential, rebuild confidence in their own abilities, and attain a quality education, despite the myriad challenges posed by war.







MEDICAL INSURANCE ASSISTANCE FOR 96 CHILDREN OF HEROES

Imperia Holding and the Isei beauty and skincare experience stores network provided support through three installments of charitable assistance totaling **499,200 UAH**. In September 2025, the Foundation received the third and final installment of this contribution.

Thanks to this significant support, we were able to arrange medical insurance for 96 children under the care of our Fund. This is an extremely important contribution to their health, safety, and confidence in the future. Every child now has access to necessary medical care, doctor consultations, and treatment when needed — something that is often unattainable without outside support.











SINEVO – LABORATORY PARTNER OF THE CHILDREN OF HEROES CHARITABLE FOUNDATION

Cooperation between the European network of medical laboratories **Sinevo** and the **Children of Heroes** Charity Fund began in March 2025. Under the charitable agreement, the fund's beneficiaries can undergo laboratory tests at Sinevo free of charge.

The laboratory provides biochemical, immunological, cytological, general clinical analyses, and comprehensive examinations. This gives children the opportunity to detect diseases in a timely manner and control chronic conditions. The cooperation helps reduce the financial burden on families and ensures equal access to quality medical care.

Since the beginning of the partnership, **232 children** have already undergone tests for a total amount of **421 480 hryvnias.** The project aims to preserve the health and improve the quality of life of children who have lost their parents due to the war.





THE STORY OF THE MONTH THAT INSPIRES

SOFIA, 9 YEARS OLD KATERYNA, 5 YEARS OLD

Not long ago, Sofia and Kateryna lived in the beautiful city of Energodar. They went to kindergarten, practiced gymnastics, and loved their parents deeply. But on February 24, everything changed: their father went to defend the city, while their mother and the two girls spent two months surviving under occupation — almost without food or communication.

Thanks to their courage and resilience, the girls managed to escape and finally hug their father. Sadly, he was later killed by a direct missile strike in Zaporizhzhia. The family has since moved to Sumy, where their mother now raises her daughters. Sofia and Kateryna are incredibly strong children who support their mom and remember their father with love and a smile. The Children of Heroes Fund continues to support the family in every possible way — they attended the Svitlyachok camp, joined a retreat in Lithuania, and have received various forms of assistance.






SUPPORT PROGRAMS
