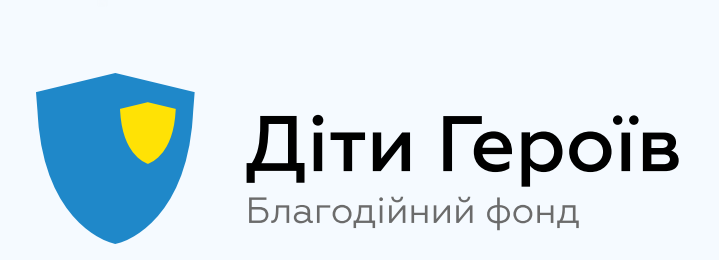
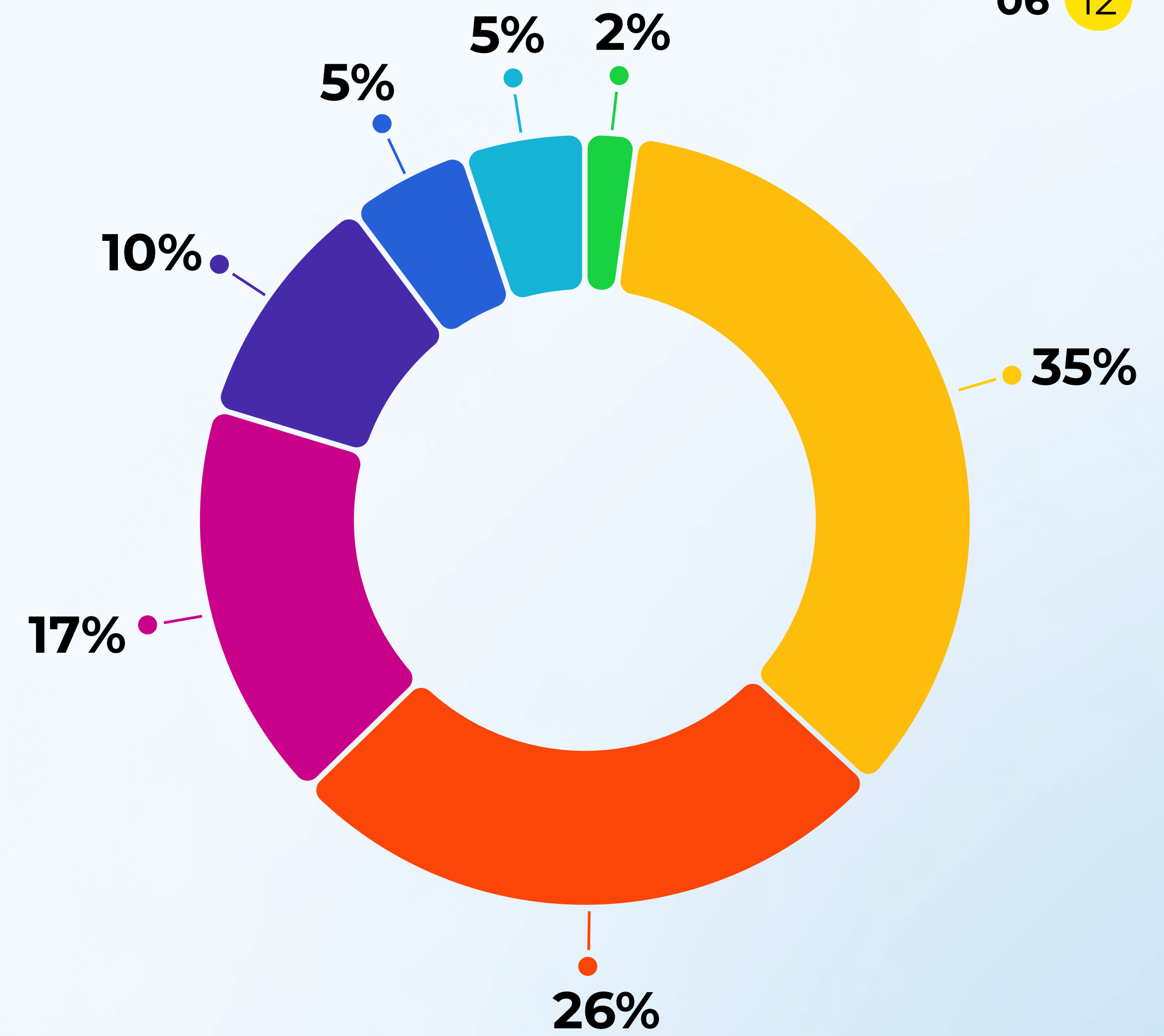
As of April 1, the Fund's team

Programs of support

The largest support program now is **emergency support** - providing immediate financial assistance to families.

The second largest is **humanitarian aid**: providing children with basic needs, including food, warm clothing, hygiene products, and lighting.

Over the course of a year, we scaled up and became **the largest fund** in Ukraine with such mission and **more than 3900 children** under our support as of today with **1286 children** joining only in January.

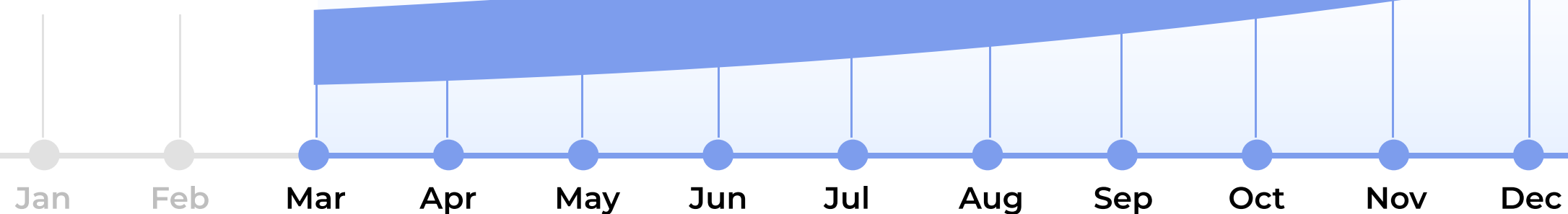

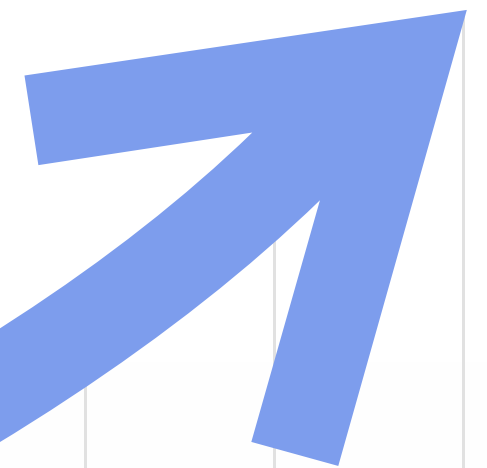
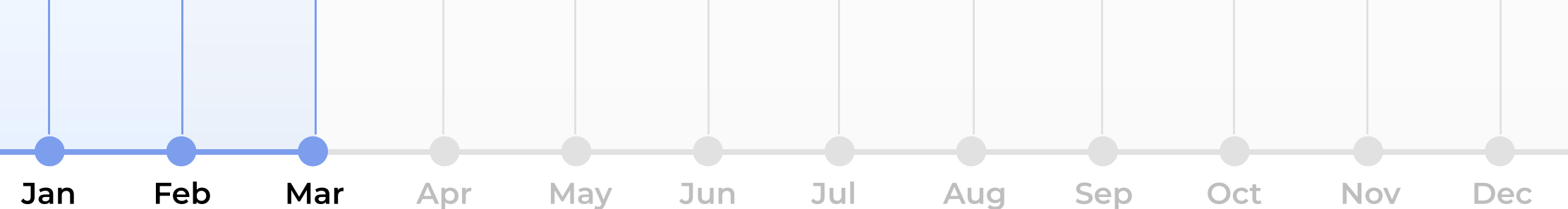
