
It was implemented due to the shelling of critical infrastructure facilities and electricity shortages. Results as of April 01, 2023:


Over **358 families** and their families received additional financial assistance from our partners at the 1K Project

and their caregiver **receives 5,000 UAH** (\$135 USD) in immediate funding after completing their verification






164 families who are in the most dire financial situation received extra **money** as financial support


Team

Programs of support


The largest support program now is **emergency support** - providing immediate financial assistance to families.

The second largest is **humanitarian aid:** providing children with basic needs, including food, warm clothing, hygiene products, and lighting.
