

#### Inspiring story of the month


Vladyslav's and Savelii's father died defending the city of Irpin on March 21, 2022.

On the very first day of the war, February 24th, 2022, Savelii's father and older brother Vladyslav defended their hometown of Irpin in northern Ukraine as part of the Territorial Defense Forces. Saveli and Vladyslav considered it their duty to serve in the TFO. On March 21st, 2022, a fierce battle took place during which Ihor, Savelii and Vladyslav's father, was fatally shot. Vladyslav desperately tried to save him, fighting until his last breath, but his father tragically died in his arms. On the day of the battle, Vladyslav was also seriously injured, and his recovery took a grueling 4 months.

Savelii took his father's death **very hard**. He began wearing a military uniform and going to the cemetery often to visit him and grieve.

During the war, the family's home was badly damaged. Its heating system and infrastructure were completely broken and the roof also required repairs. While the family was waiting for the windows to be replaced, which took place in mid-December, mold also appeared in the home.

Thanks to the Fund, the family received priority financial assistance, a home first aid kit from Teva, financial support from the 1K Project, a gift for International Children's Day, and financial assistance for the reconstruction of their home. They can now live in comfort and dignity once again.






#### Programs of support

The largest support program now is **emergency support** - providing immediate financial assistance to families.


The second largest is **child welfare assistants:** they are our direct and constant link with the families who help us to track every contact with the children and maximize our support to them.























Over the course of a year, we scaled up and became the largest fund in Ukraine with such mission. There are more than 5800 children under our support as of today.
