Inspiring story of the month

Masha Plakhova's life changed on October 30, 2022, when she lost her father in the war.

During this period, the Foundation has repeatedly provided the family with all kinds of assistance: priority financial assistance (for which Masha bought a jacket, sweater and pants); spring clothes from Levi's; Masha had the opportunity to study with tutors (in math and English) for a whole year; she passed a large list of tests prescribed by an endocrinologist at the Cinevo medical laboratory for free; and recently received sneakers.

And most importantly, the Foundation made Masha's dream come true by providing her with the opportunity to study in England for the whole month of August. She has been dreaming of such training, as she really wants to learn the language perfectly so that her father could be proud of her from heaven.

Today Masha arrived in Ukraine. But the surprises were not over. At home, she received another gift from the Children of Heroes Fund, a long-awaited laptop for her studies, which she had not even expected.

The family is grateful to the Fund for making miracles happen.

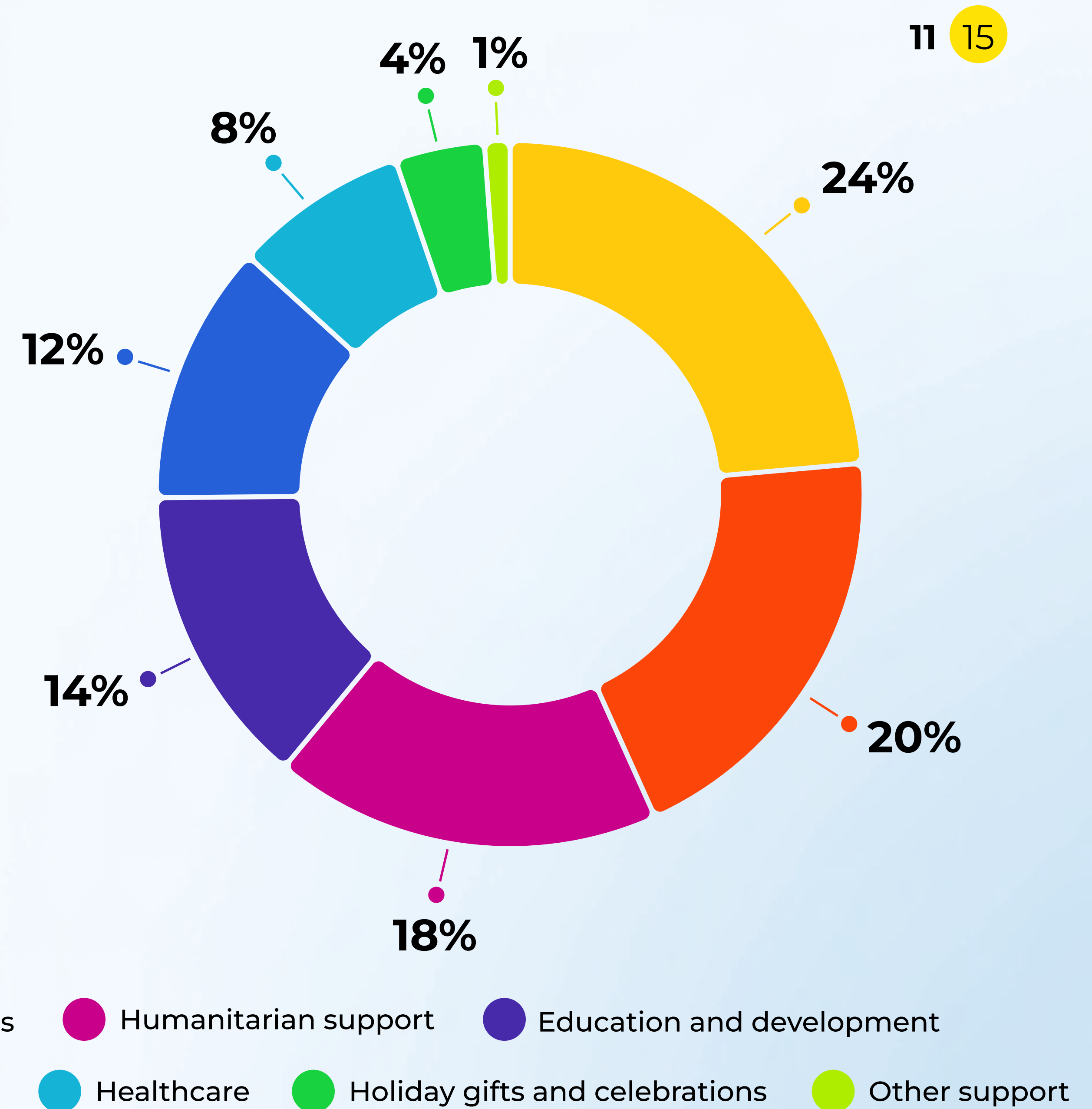
