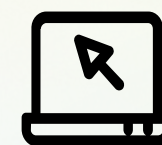

Darnytsia - partner with the most significant contribution in March

During war, access to medical services is limited, and families who have lost loved ones are often left without the necessary. **Darnytsia provided 3,000 first-aid kits** with vital medicines for children who have experienced loss, evacuation and stress-related illnesses.

Inspiring story of the month

Maria, 12 years old

Maria is an excellent student who really loves music. She plays the bandura professionally, performs at concerts, and has recently started learning the guitar. But behind her achievements is a sensitive story. The loss of her father coincided with a difficult period of growing up, and the girl experienced deep grief.

Her mother, Mrs. Oksana, decided to enroll Maria in the psychological rehabilitation camp “Litokryl”. This step was a turning point: Maria returned from the camp inspired, with new friends and renewed emotional resources.

Today, she continues to actively participate in the Foundation’s initiatives, and is currently improving her English at “Tutor Camp”. Her story is a reminder of how timely support can change everything.

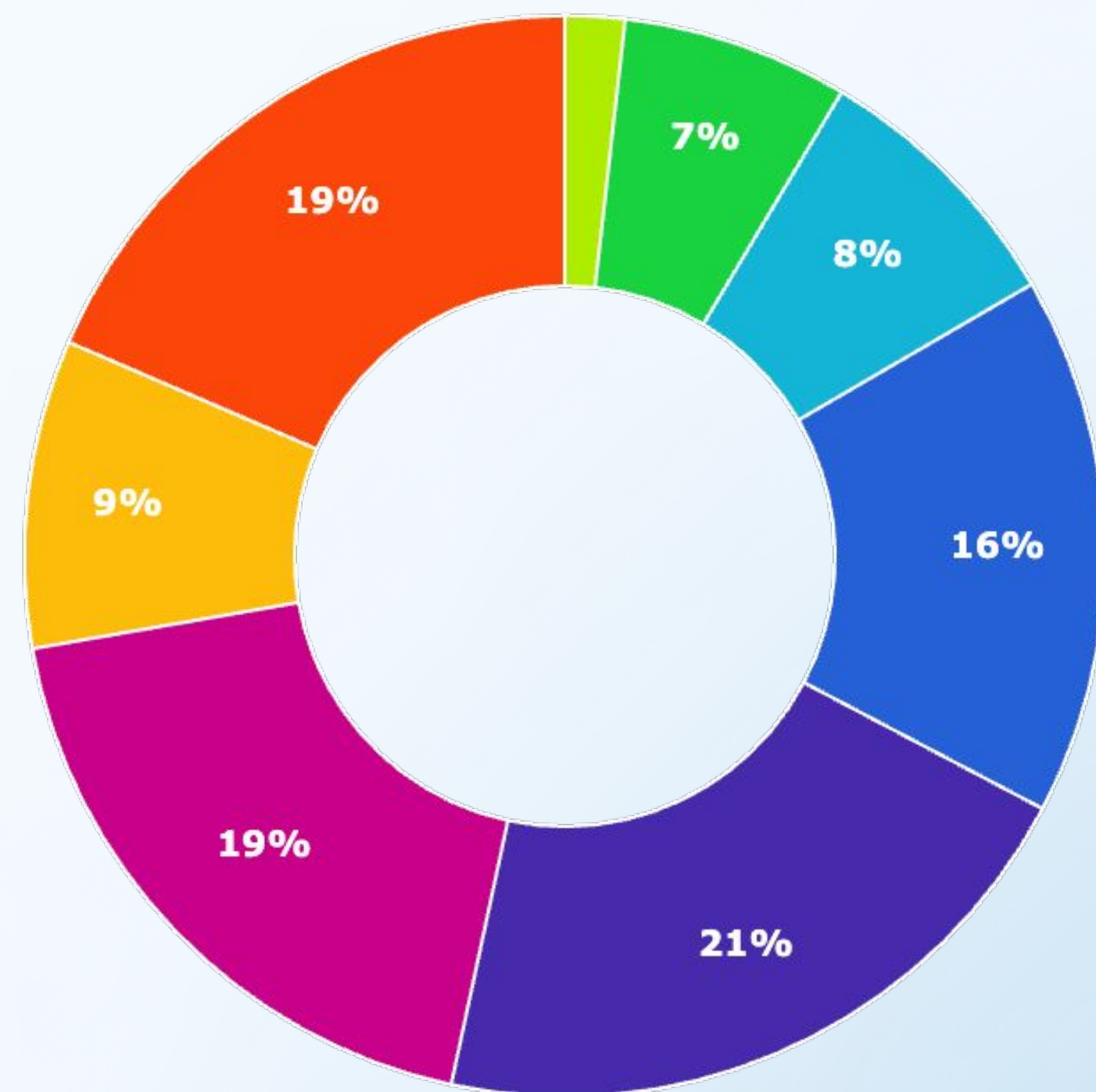

Programs of support

The largest support programs over the years of the foundation's existence are:

- **Education and Development** - a variety of programs aimed at the comprehensive development of children
- **Family Helpers** - they are our direct and constant link with families
- **Humanitarian Support** - providing families with food and hygiene kits, which are critically important for their well-being
- **Psychological Support and Rehabilitation** - helps families normalize their condition after the loss
