DataArt invests 770 000 in socialization of Children of Heroes


Atlas Camp in Ivano-Frankivsk Oblast - 22 children received a unique experience of in-depth English language learning. In addition to language practice, the camp included excursions to Hutsulland, a cheese factory, the UPA Museum, and others; hiking; workshops and master classes; theme parties and disco parties.

Another 20 children interested in the IT field will spend 10 days in the picturesque Carpathians, where they will combine learning with vivid impressions.

In addition to the educational part, they will have quests, parties, master classes, hiking, talent shows, volleyball, etc.

2.4 million of goodness from Oleyna

In the first half of 2025, Oleina donated UAH 2 million 400 thousand to our foundation. These funds were used to organize summer camps for vulnerable children and provide psychological support.

Part of the funding was used to develop educational programs and opportunities for children.

Almost UAH 2 million for camps and medicine from Antoshka

In the first six months of 2025, Antoshka donated almost UAH 2 million to support the wards of the Children of Heroes Charitable Foundation. Of this amount, about UAH 1.6 million was allocated for medical needs - treatment, rehabilitation and medicines. Another UAH 400 thousand was spent on summer camps for children who lost their parents in the war. This assistance was extremely important for the families in the most difficult periods of their lives. We are sincerely grateful to Antoshka for their trust, care and concern. Together we are creating a future where there is room for support, hope and children's smiles.





Inspiring story of the month

Volodymyr, 12 years old

Volodymyr is 12 and lives in Lviv with his mother. Shortly before the full-scale war, the family moved here, hoping for a new beginning. But their lives changed - Volodymyr's father, a soldier, went missing near Ruske Porichne. His mother recognized him in a photo from a telegram channel - her heart couldn't be wrong, even though he is still officially listed as missing. Her struggle is daily appeals to bring his body home, to give her son the opportunity to say goodbye. Despite the loss, Volodymyr remains strong - he is preparing for the 7th grade, is fond of programming and playing sports. The Children of Heroes charitable foundation supports the family - thanks to Intertop, the boy received new shoes. This summer, Volodya will go to the Expedition camp, where he will go rafting, mountaineering and quests. He is looking forward to these adventures. The Nazarenko's story is a story of loss, strength and unbreakable love


Programs of support


