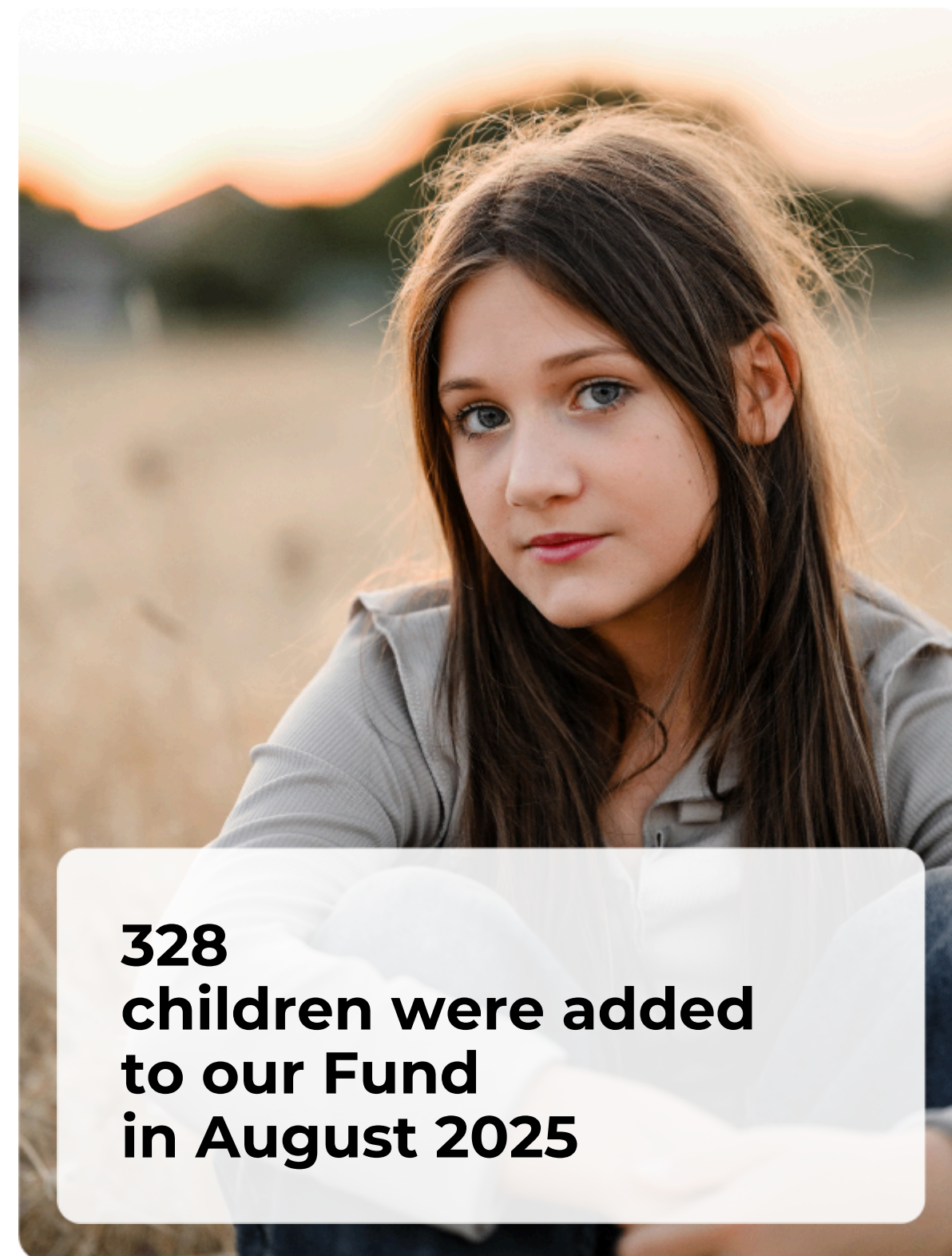
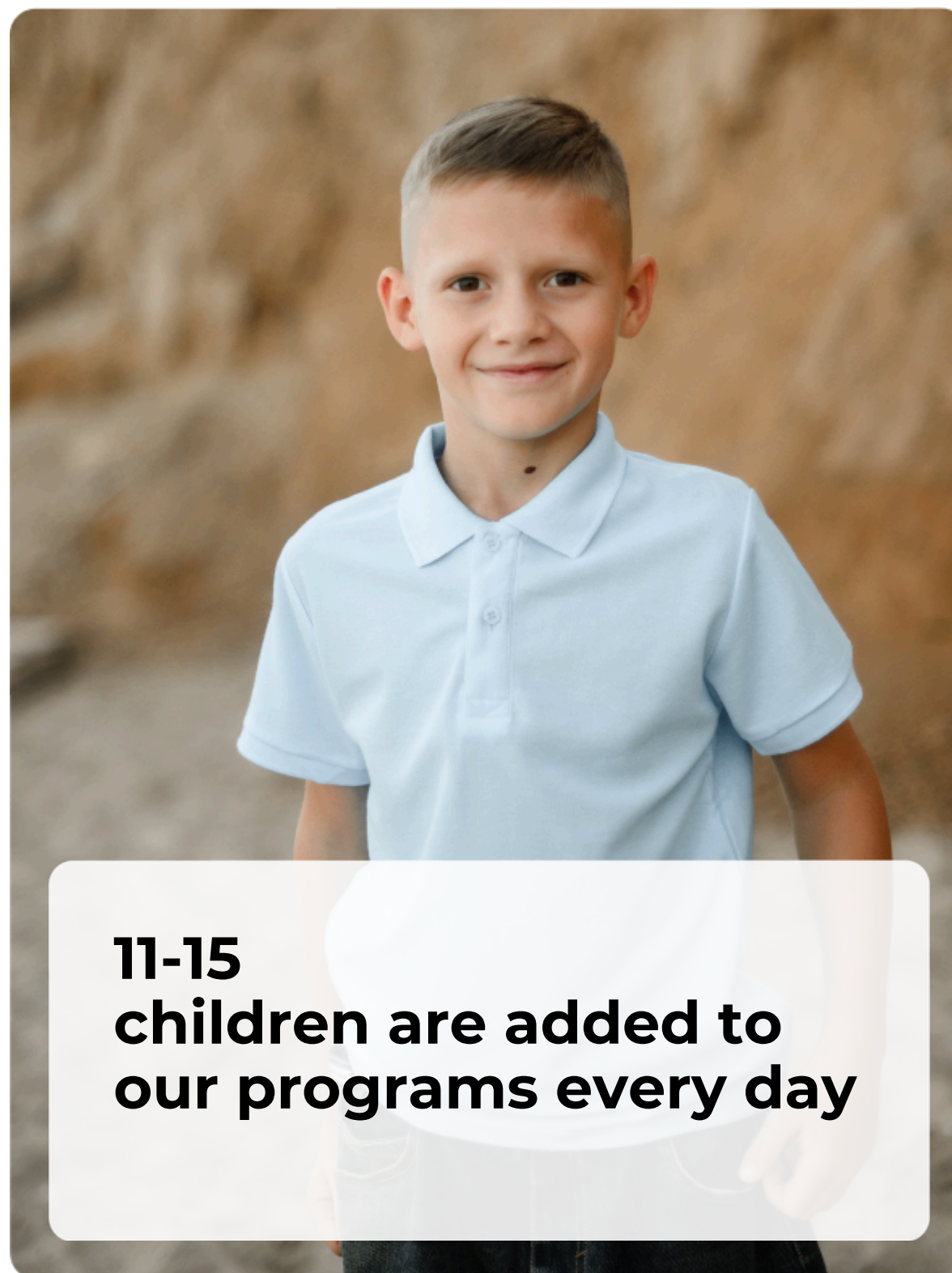
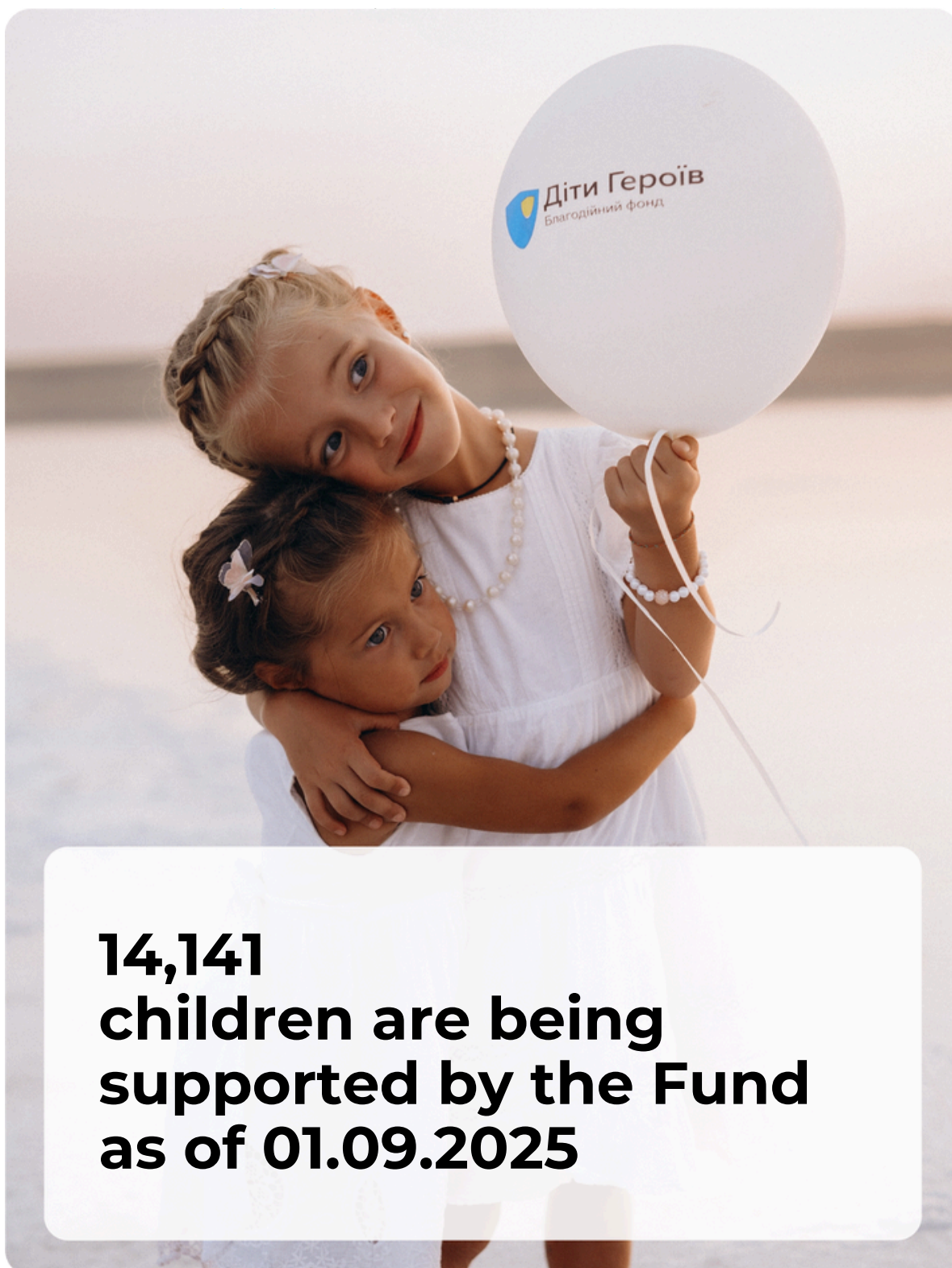

Camps create a unique environment where everyone shares each other's experiences, helping children feel supported.



THE HOUSE OF GOODNESS IN KRAKOW

On August 23-24, an event was held at an art picnic in Krakow. Children of Heroes Charity Fund joined the event with our interactive initiative «THE HOUSE OF GOODNESS.» It's a space where support became visible: after making a contribution, each guest received a support ribbon and could either weave it into the installation or keep it as a personal symbol of remembrance.

How it worked:

- Donation: 25 PLN or 4 EUR
- Thank you for the donation: a support ribbon for THE HOUSE OF GOODNESS—or to keep as a memento
- Purpose: to help children who have lost one or both parents due to the war in Ukraine

What we achieved:

Over two days, we raised 900 EUR. All funds will be directed to support our beneficiaries. The event proved that even small, regular contributions can have a tangible impact when many caring people come together.



Thanks to this project, children will have access to education, development, and new opportunities. The funds will also provide patronage for three children who have lost one or both parents. They will receive the necessary support in their education, upbringing, and daily life. Genesis' assistance is an example of corporate social responsibility and genuine solidarity. Investing in children's education and development is an investment in Ukraine's future. 2,000 SETS OF STATIONERY AND 980 BACKPACKS FROM KITE

INSPIRING STORY OF THE MONTH

ARTEM, 15 YEARS OLD

When the father of 15-year-old Artem died at the front, the boy's world fell apart. Depression, despair, complete rejection of sports and school—he repeated only one thing: «I'm waiting until I'm 18. I'll go to war and punish everyone who is responsible for my father's death.» Psychologists couldn't reach him.

But his mother found her way through art. She began painting ammunition shells, turning them into unique art objects. She worked 17 hours a day. The works were sold at auctions, and all the proceeds went to the rifle brigade fighting in the Donetsk region, where Artem's father had died. Every Sunday, the soldiers sent videos: they signed the shells «from son to father» and fired them. Step by step, the boy calmed down. He felt that revenge was happening. But not through hatred—through action. The family is from Zaporizhia; their apartment was bombed, and now they live in Vilniansk.

Artem has returned to sports, has an adult swimming classification, and holds a record in the 400 m medley. He often goes fishing—it's his new way of healing, just like watching sunrises and sunsets together. The family is learning to move on and find small joys, even in the little things.

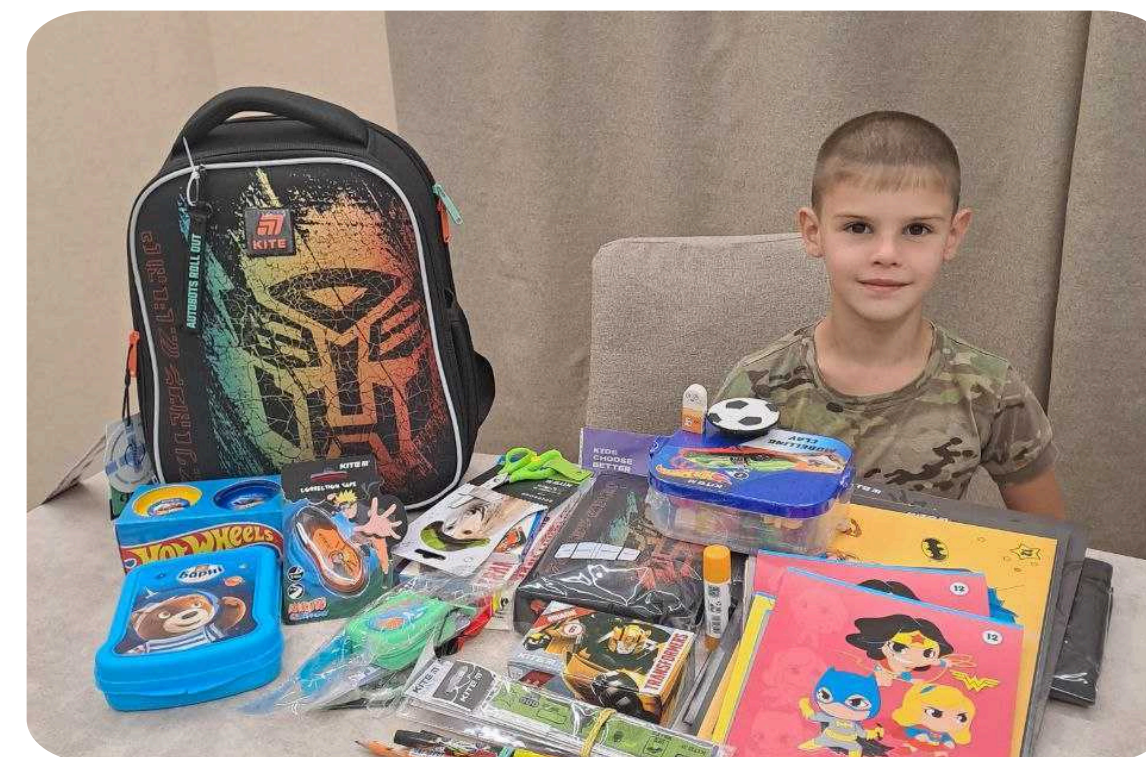
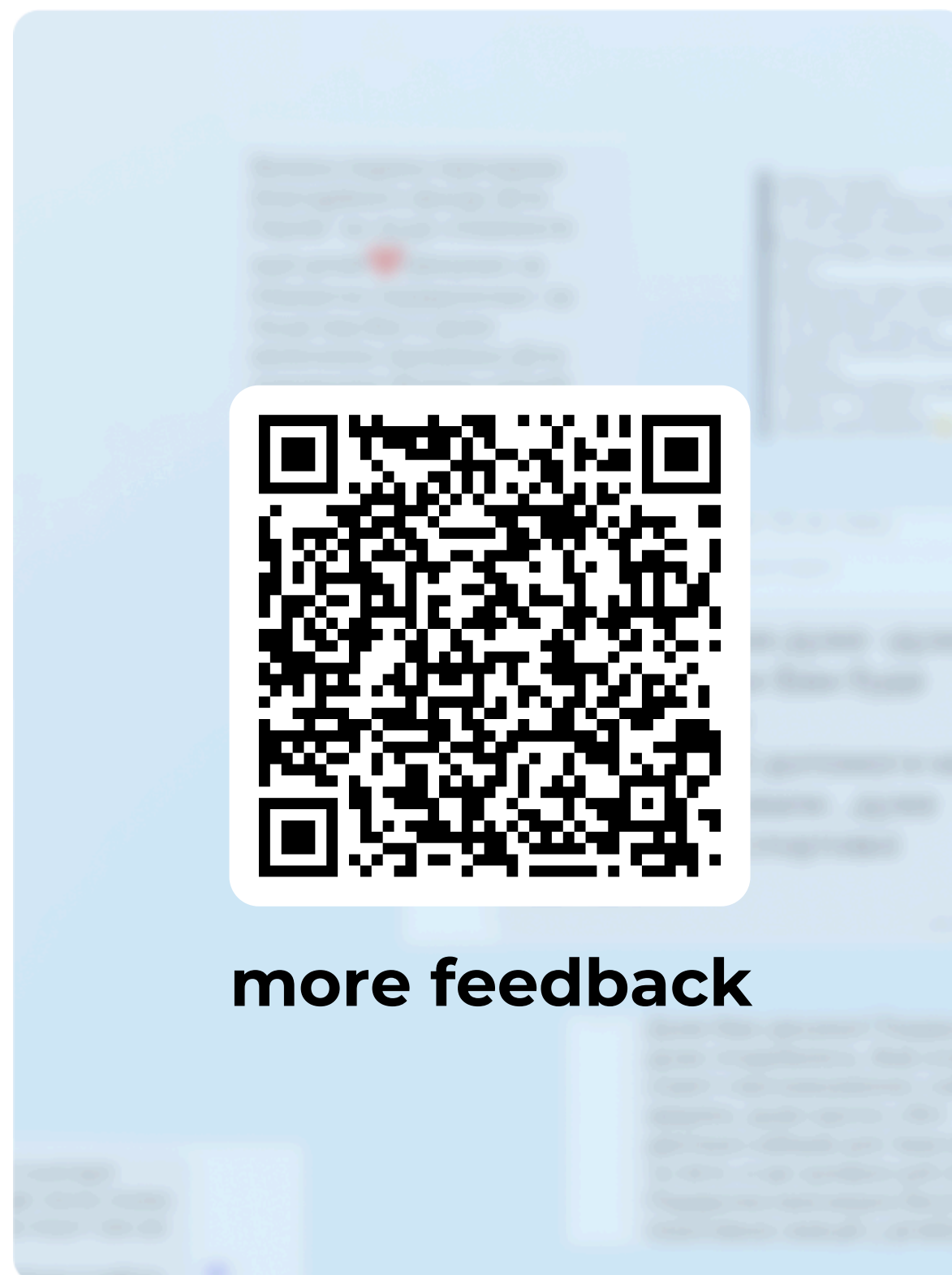
