





The Children of Heroes Charity Fund and the Ministry of Veterans Affairs of Ukraine have joined forces to strengthen support for children who have lost one or both parents as a result of the war. The signing of a Memorandum of Cooperation is an important step toward a systemic approach that will provide children of Heroes with the conditions they need for development, education, and socialization.



#### **EDUCATION FOR CHILDREN OF HEROES**



# **UKRSIBBANK BNP Paribas Group supported the «Education for Children of Heroes» project.**

UKRSIBBANK provided vital support for 35 children to pursue educational projects. Thanks to a generous donation of over UAH 400,000, the children were able to keep learning and developing even amid wartime conditions.

Over five months, they successfully completed IT programming courses and took part in group mathematics classes. This initiative helped them regain confidence and see new prospects for the future. #### **«FEEL YOUR IMPACT» ANNUAL EVENT**

On October 29 in Kyiv, the Children of Heroes Charity Fund held its annual **«Feel Your Impact»** event, bringing together representatives of business, the public sector, and international organizations. The aim was to review joint initiatives, discuss current challenges, and set priorities for further support of children who have lost one or both parents due to the war. The event was opened by the Fund's CEO, Tetiana Novytska, who emphasized that thanks to partners and supporters, the Fund has been providing comprehensive assistance to children of Heroes for more than three years—from material aid to psychological, educational, and mentoring support.

### UNITING HEARTS FOR CHILDREN OF HEROES







Thanks to CHER'17, which launched sales of charitable horse figurines and sticker packs, more than UAH 800,000 was raised. All funds will support projects of the Children of Heroes Charity Fund. In particular, part of the amount will go to the «Warmth for Children» program, which provides children with essential items for a comfortable life. Financial support will also be directed to the «Career Guidance for Teens» educational project, designed for school students who are choosing their future profession and field of study. In addition, part of the funds will support the «Christmas Miracle: New Year Gifts» initiative, which brings children a celebration and warm emotions.

For a long time, CHER'17 has been supporting the Fund's beneficiaries and making a meaningful contribution to good causes.



#### THE INSPIRING STORY OF THE MONTH

## **DMYTRO AND VOLODYMYR, 13**

Both boys live with serious health conditions—central nervous system disorders, epilepsy, and bronchial asthma—and have official disability status. Their mother also has a disability and manages diabetes, yet she refuses to let hardship stand in the way of her sons' education.

Dmytro and Volodymyr are exceptionally capable, diligent, and determined. They do well at school and take part in academic Olympiads, winning prizes. With pride, their mother says that despite the diagnoses, the boys are «very smart and hardworking.» This month, the Fund provided the family with over UAH 120,000 in assistance for the boys' treatment. For their mother, it was vital support.

«For me, this is more than just help,» the mother says. «It's a sign that we are not alone—that people remember us and value my husband's work. It gives me strength and faith.»






### **ASSISTANCE INITIATIVES**
