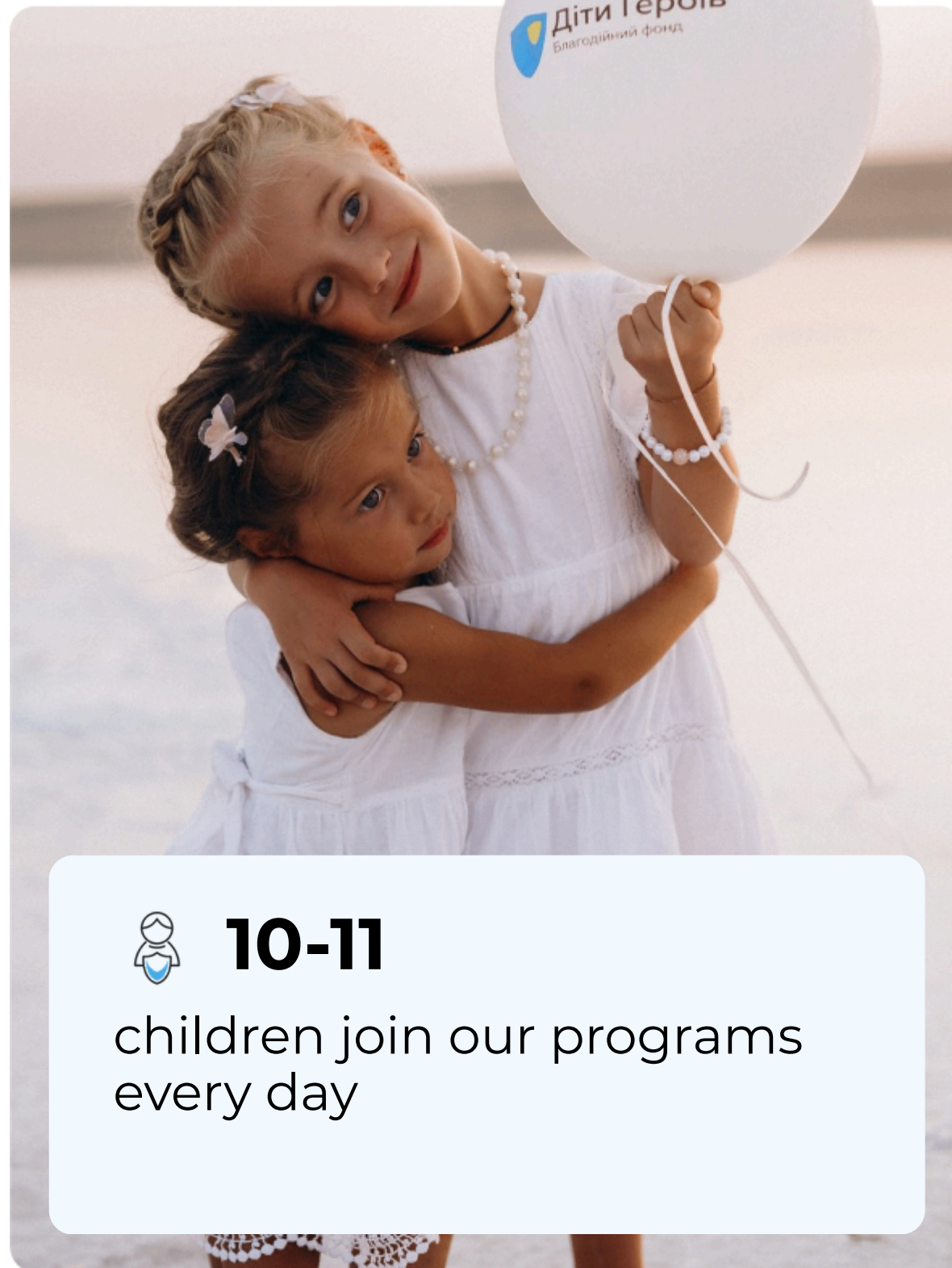

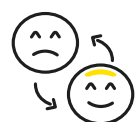

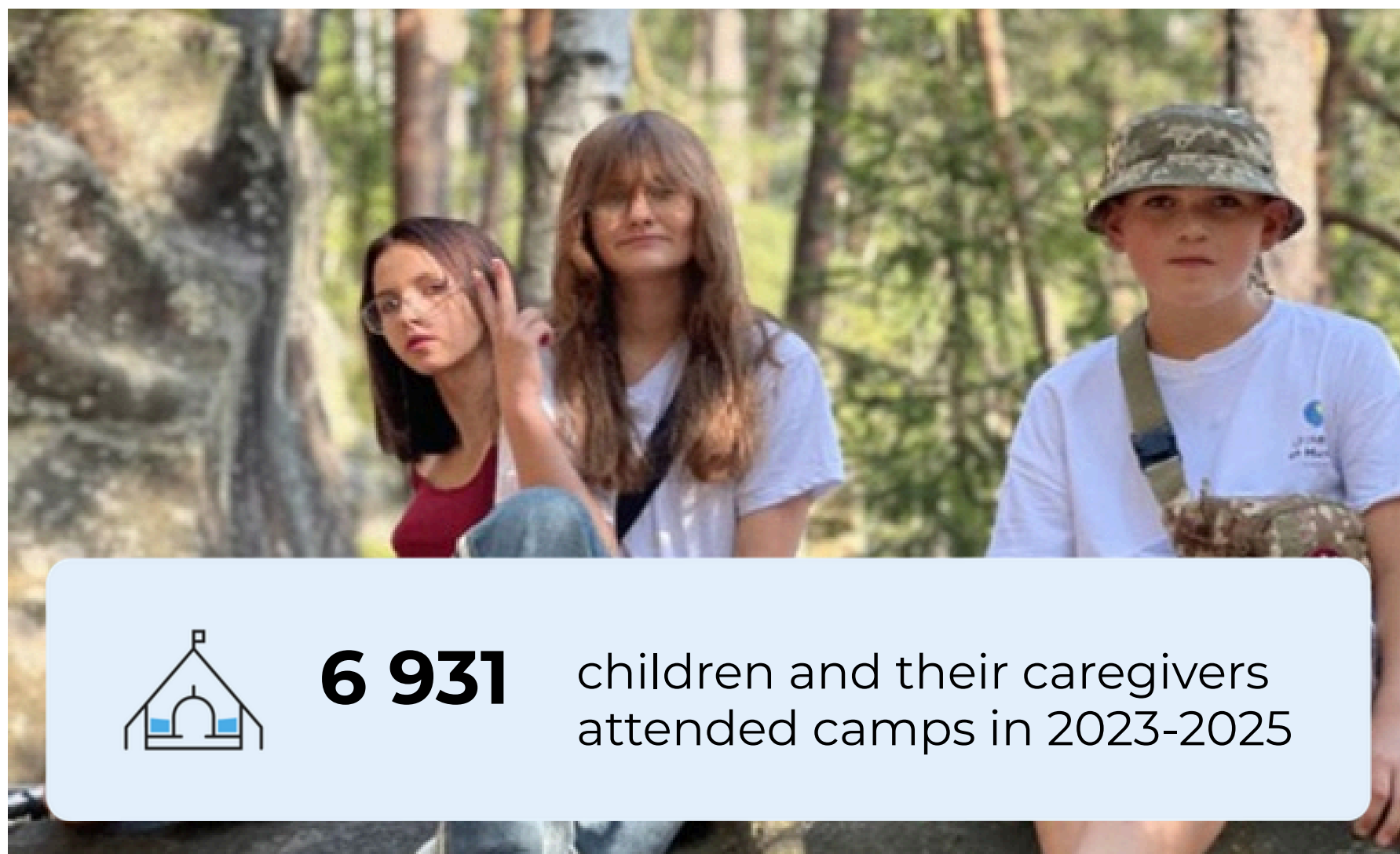

«COLORS THAT REPRODUCE LIFE» IN TALLINN



In the very heart of Estonia's capital, stories began to resonate, told not with words but with paint. The exhibition features **14 artworks by beneficiaries of the Children of Heroes Charity Fund**, children who have endured the deepest losses over nearly four years of the full-scale war. Next to each painting, visitors can read a short note from the young artist, honest and unembellished, sometimes painful, but profoundly real. The event is meant to draw the international community's attention to the consequences of Russia's aggression and its impact on children.

The exhibition took place as part of the «Standing with Ukraine» program, with the support of the Tallinn Black Nights Film Festival (PÖFF), as another way to remind the world that behind every wartime statistic there is a child's story.

Yehor, 7, and Diana, 9

The children lost their mother as a result of one of the attacks on the city of Sumy. She was killed during a missile strike. After the trauma, Diana developed a nervous tic and obsessive, repetitive movements. Yehor has speech difficulties and needs fairly intensive sessions with a speech therapist. He finds it hard to trust people, and the sessions themselves are very challenging for him.

The family has received substantial help and support from the Fund and partners, including financial assistance for doctor-recommended pool sessions for Diana and speech therapy sessions for Yehor. The family has already started these sessions.

Their father notes significant positive changes. They are deeply grateful for the care, help, and ongoing support in any form. Thanks to this, the children have begun to smile more often, something that had been very rare lately.



The most significant support programs at present are:

Education and development.

This program gives children the opportunity to realize their potential even in the most difficult circumstances.

Psychological Support and Socialization is the Fund's team of specialists who provide daily psychological support to the Fund's beneficiaries and their guardians.
