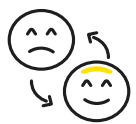

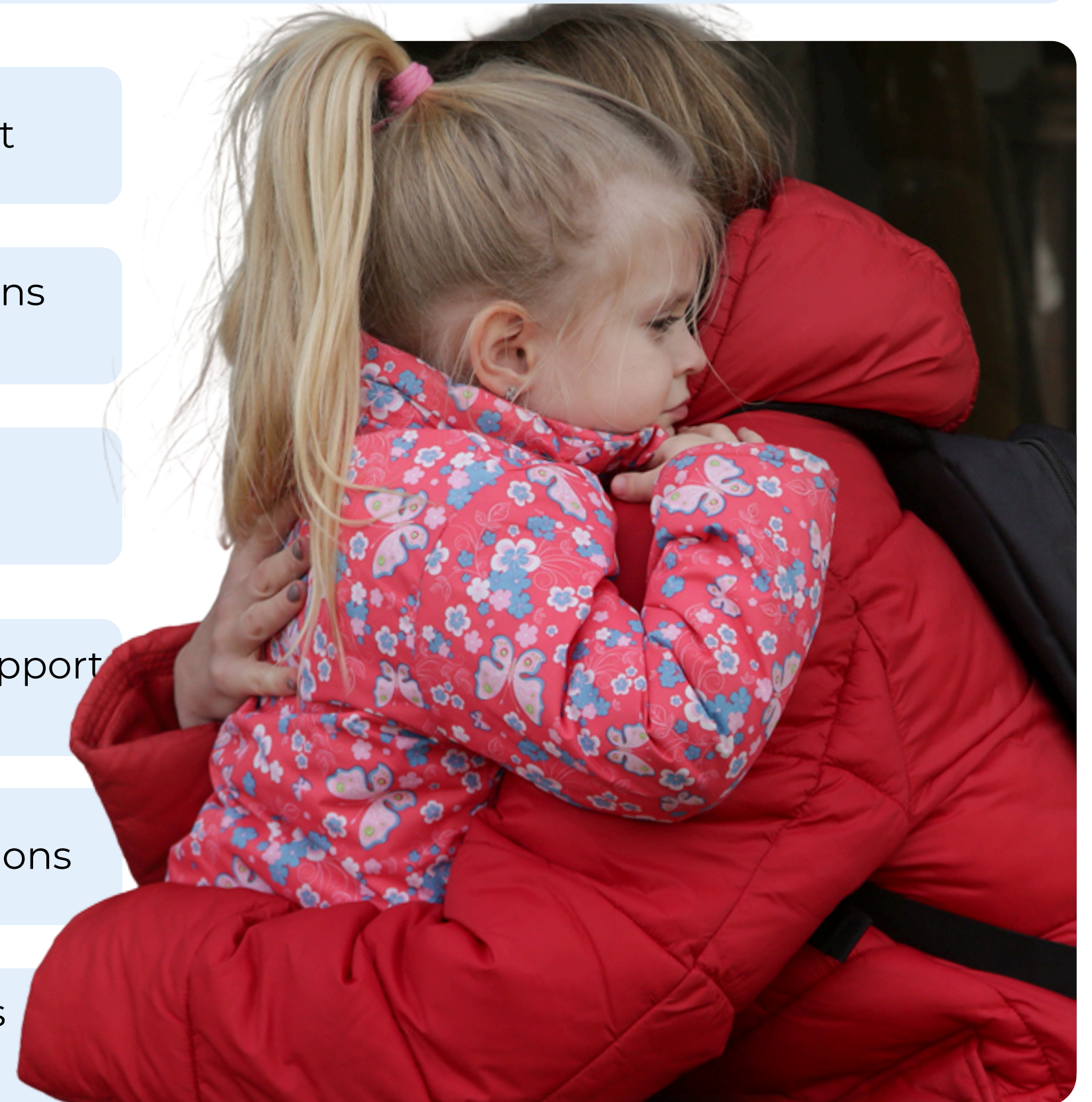

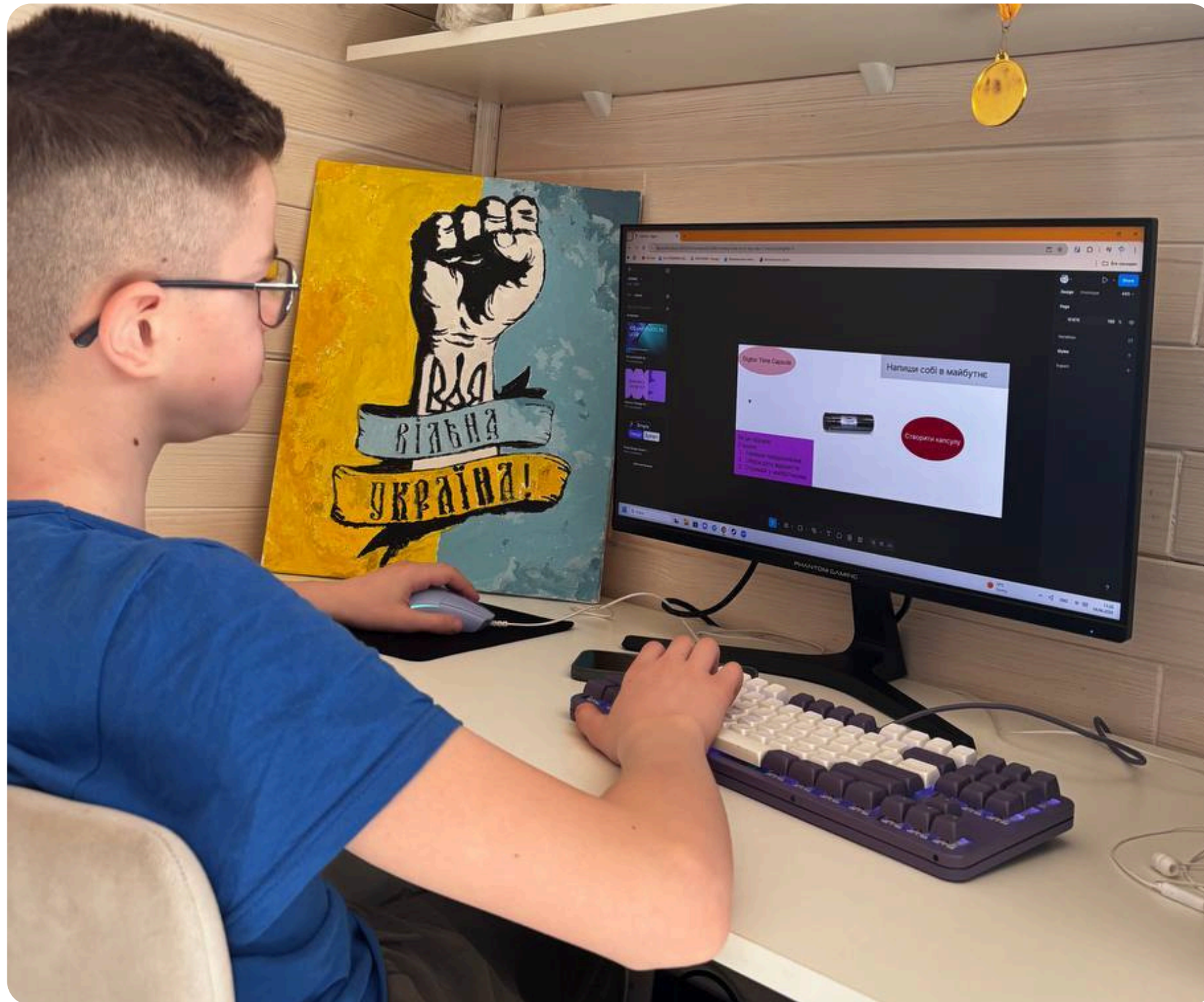

## «UKRAINE IN A BACKPACK»: WHEN PREPARING FOR EXAMS BECOMES A LIFE-CHANGING JOURNEY

«Ukraine in a Backpack» is The Eneida Foundation's flagship project, helping teenagers travel across Ukraine and rediscover its history, culture, and natural heritage.

Each trip was designed with the National Multi-Subject Test in mind. Instead of dull lectures, the programme offered historical quests, vivid storytelling, and interactive activities. Throughout the journey, the teenagers, beneficiaries of the Children of Heroes Charity Fund, kept workbooks, noting down dates, events, and names in the very places where history was made. Psychologists worked with the children during all three trips. Through shared evenings and group discussions, they learned to trust, open up, and support one another.

We are grateful to our partners for giving our beneficiaries the opportunity to discover the real Ukraine and to learn something truly meaningful.



## CONCERT BY THE BAND «ANTYTILA» — «AT HOME»



ANTYTILA frontman Taras Topolia has become an ambassador for the Education Programme of the Children of Heroes Charity Fund.

On 20 March, he gave the Fund's beneficiaries a truly special experience: ANTYTILA's major concert, At Home, which brought together 236 children and their guardians at Kyiv's Palace of Sports. For many families, this was far more than just a concert. It was a warm and meaningful experience: a chance to see their favourite band live and to feel an atmosphere of unity, support, and genuine emotional connection.

We are deeply grateful to Taras Topolia and ANTYTILA for this important gesture of support for our children.



Antoshka is one of our long-standing partners. Thanks to this ongoing support, we are able to cover a vital share of the emergency medical needs of the children in our care.

One such story is that of 10-year-old Ihor. He loves computer games and spending time outdoors with friends, but every day he lives with a severe form of diabetes. The condition requires constant monitoring, exhausts him physically, and significantly limits his everyday life.

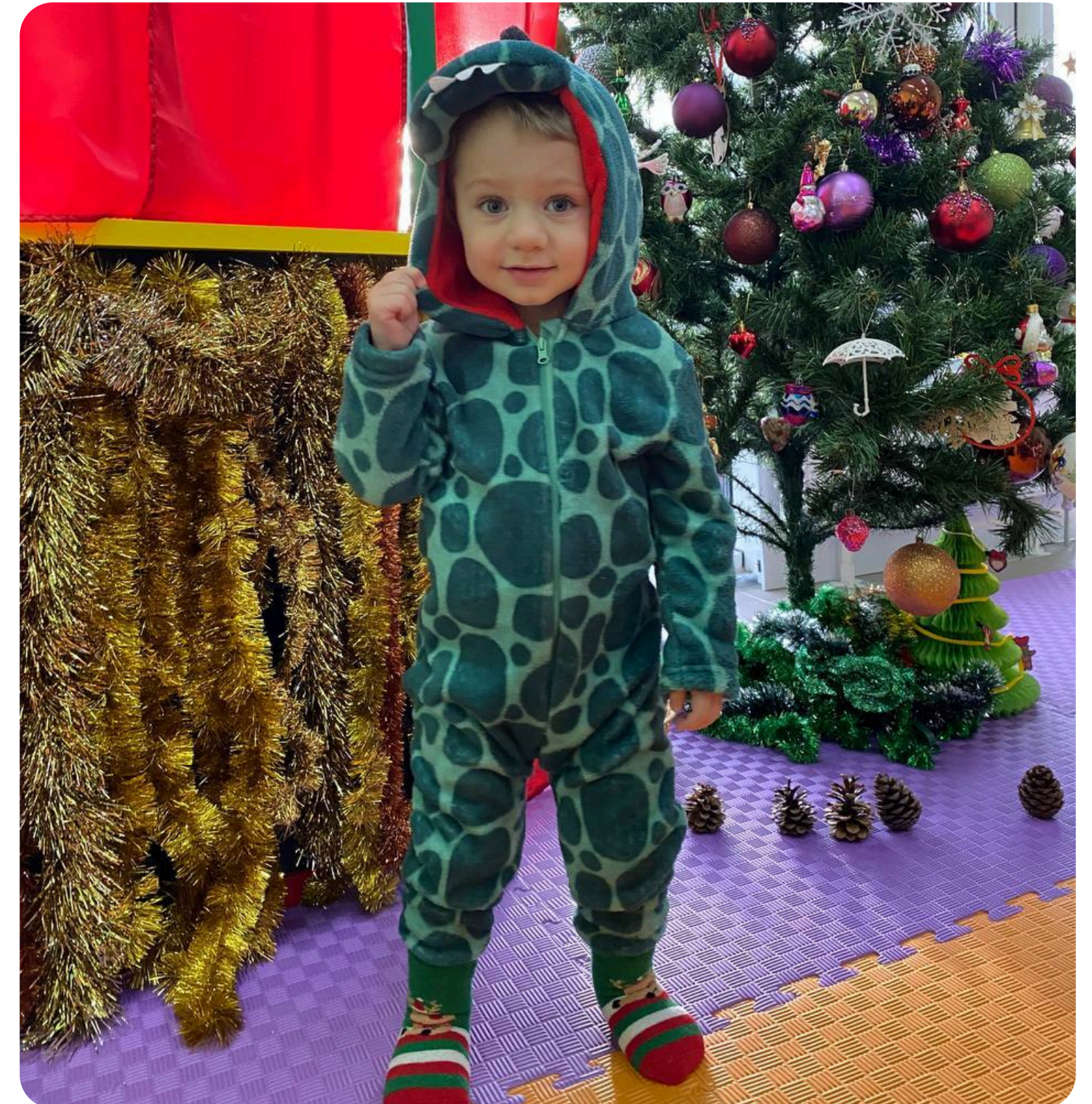
An insulin pump has given Ihor a chance at greater stability and a safer childhood. Thanks to Antoshka's support, his family was able to purchase the pump and the necessary supplies for a period of time. And this is just one of many examples of how regular partner support changes children's lives every single month.

### Oleksander, 3 years

Oleksandr's family from Brovary suffered a tragic loss in October 2023, when his father died from severe injuries caused by explosions during combat. Despite her grief, his mother, Inna, focused on supporting her son, whose main challenge was delayed speech.

With the support of its partners, the Children of Heroes Charity Fund covered the cost of one-to-one speech therapy sessions, which gave a strong boost to Oleksandr's development. The Fund also provided humanitarian aid and psychological support to help the family cope.

«The sessions brought real results, and for us this is more than just support,» says Inna. «It is a sign that we are not alone, that we are remembered, and that our father's sacrifice is valued.»



## The most significant support programmes at present are:

### Education and development.

This programme gives children the opportunity to realise their potential even in the most difficult circumstances.

**Psychological support and socialisation** is one of the Fund's core areas of work, helping families access psychological care and ensuring they do not have to face loss alone.
